





Measure the true size of the album page, and size your layouts approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch smaller so that a bit of the painted edge shows. Print your pages, and trim them with a trimmer that will give you crisp straight edges.



Ink your edges. [If you use a chalk or pigment ink you may want to heat set for permanence.]



Using your favorite paper to paper glue, attach your photos in the desired order.

Important to remember: keep in mind any embellishments you may want to be adding to finished product, so that the backs may be hidden if necessary. It will affect the order in which you glue your pages and embellishments down.

In the photo below I glued down the photo after I attached the brass corners and the beaded flower so the backs will be hidden.
